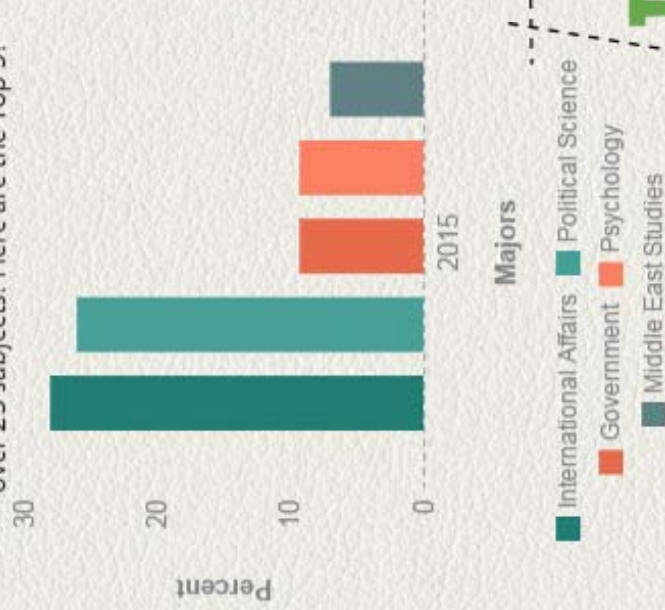


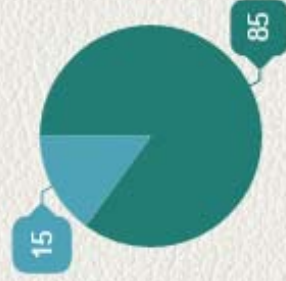

English, French, Arabic, Spanish, Mandarin Chinese, Russian.

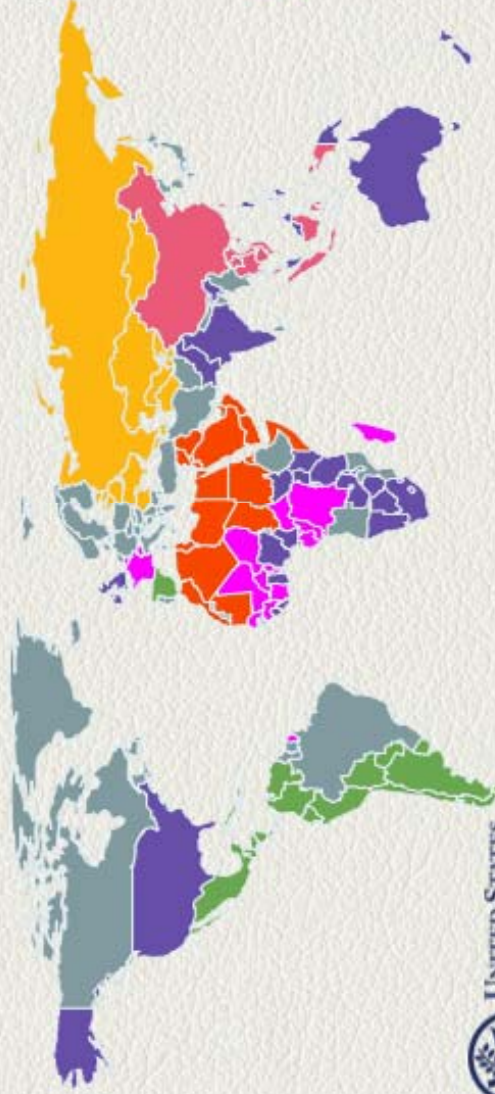
INTERNSHIPS
